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As a believer I longed to know the Gospel more clearly, what I believed. How I would faithfully present that Gospel as it transforms life to maturity, to the few friends I had. I longed to understand what a biblical church looks like and how that could be achieved. In the circles I was involved in, the gospel was mostly misrepresented or halfway backed. Chances of faithful representation of the Gospel were rare to find. I too, felt inadequate to be a faithful worker of the Gospel.

I heard of Utumishi Course hoping my expectations will be met. To my surprise, my understanding of salvation was I thought I had chosen to be saved but God had actually chosen me. In my own nature I am corrupted to even will anything godly but through the work of the Holy Spirit my heart of stone was changed. The sessions we had studying various books of the Bible and the whole Bible sharpened my skills in Bible study. I gained a clearer understanding of the Bible as one story with one soul author as God. I also began to study the scriptures more and daily.

I have been challenged to work excellently and skillfully especially in what pertains the gospel, a Sunday school teaching, a mid-week fellowship preaching, to youth ministry and all my hand finds to do.

I learned all that is needed was to faithfully teach the scriptures and the light will shine in a darkened heart making all things visible bringing them to light.
