Ministry Training Course

The January 2026 Ministry Training Course (MTC) was held for one week under the theme "Total Gospel." The training brought together 36 apprentices for biblical teaching and practical ministry training. The goal was to ground apprentices in a clear understanding of the gospel and equip them for faithful and effective ministry. Additional training included Old Testament Survey, Habakkuk Bible Study and Micro-Preaching which were appreciated for their biblical depth and practical relevance.

Highlights

One of the impactful elements of the MTC was the exposition of Romans, which helped apprentices gain deeper clarity on key gospel truths such as sin, justification and assurance of salvation. The study of Malachi was also highly appreciated particularly for its practical What, Why, and So What framework, which strengthened apprentices' sermon preparation and Bible teaching skills.



Bonface Kamunyo says "I was refreshed by the MTC, especially through micro-preaching, which stretched and shaped me by helping me remain faithful to the biblical text and grow in preaching God's Word with clarity and integrity. Studying the book of Habakkuk deeply encouraged me, particularly Habakkuk 2:4b, '...but the righteous shall live by his faith,' which reminded me to keep trusting God and His Word even when injustice, evil, and ungodliness seem to prevail. Like Habakkuk, I was reminded that it is okay to ask hard questions while holding firmly to what I know about God—His unchanging character—which leads me to worship Him with renewed confidence and assurance grounded in His faithfulness through the generations."

TransformD Season 10

We are delighted to welcome the 10th cohort of TransformD participants this year. TransformD is an ex-candidate discipleship program designed to ground participants in the Word of God through a deeper understanding of Scripture. The program also equips them with practical life skills such as first aid, kitchen gardening, computer training, alongside biblical topics.

A key pillar of the program is mentorship. Each participant is paired with a mentor who walks closely with them, offering guidance, encouragement and accountability as they navigate different seasons of life. This relational aspect of the program provides a safe space for growth, reflection, and spiritual maturity.



The program also offers participants an opportunity to take part in a mission experience, where they are trained and exposed to practical ways of sharing their faith. This experience prepares them to confidently engage others with the gospel and helps cultivate a heart for service and mission.
